## 2019 Medicare Part B Reimbursement for Retirees

For 2019, most Medicare Part B premiums will be the standard \$135.50 per month. If your and/or your spouse's 2018 Medicare Part B premium reimbursement is equal to or greater than \$119.00 per month or \$357.00 per quarter, the EUTF will automatically adjust your and/or your spouse's Medicare Part B premium reimbursement for 2019 to \$135.50 per month or \$406.50 per quarter, **you do not have to do anything.**

If your and/or your spouse's 2018 Medicare Part B premium reimbursement is less than \$119.00 per month or \$357.00 per quarter, the EUTF will not change your current reimbursement to the standard amount of \$135.50. You must submit a copy of your 2019 Social Security Administration (SSA) letter indicating your Medicare Part B premium to receive the correct reimbursement from the EUTF; otherwise, you will be reimbursed the same amount as in 2018.

If your and/or your spouse's Medicare Part B premium for 2019 is an amount greater than the standard amount of \$135.50, you must provide EUTF with a copy of your and/or your spouse's SSA letter indicating your Medicare Part B premium to receive the correct reimbursement from the EUTF. Members who pay an income-related monthly adjusted amount have up to two (2) years to submit a copy of their SSA letter or invoice in order to receive the income adjustments above the standard premium. If the EUTF reimburses you an amount which is more than what you are paying, you will be subject to collection of the overpayment and it may affect future reimbursements.
