#### **FAQs**

#### Why do I need to name a beneficiary?

Life insurance benefits are generally not governed by your will, so the only way to make sure your policy's benefits are paid to the people you intend is to make sure you've named a beneficiary.

Although it is not mandatory that you name a beneficiary, it is highly recommended to ensure that the benefits are paid in accordance with your wishes and as soon as possible.

#### How many people do I name as beneficiaries?

- You can split the benefit among beneficiaries, as long as the total shares equal 100%.
- Designate at least one primary beneficiary. Consider also designating a contingent beneficiary to receive benefit if the primary beneficiary is not alive at time of claim.

#### Can I designate a minor child as beneficiary?

Yes. Just keep in mind that minors cannot directly receive life insurance proceeds. The portion of the life insurance benefit designated for a minor can be paid to the minor's estate or held at Securian Financial (earning interest) until the child is an adult.

### Can I designate a beneficiary residing outside the United States?

Yes. If your beneficiary lives outside of the U.S., please be extra careful with detail (full name, address, email address).

### Why would I return to the site to make changes?

One of your beneficiaries may have a new last name or have moved. Or you may want to change your designation based on a life milestone such as marriage or a child becoming an adult.

#### What happens if I do not designate beneficiaries?

If you do not make a beneficiary designation or if there is no named beneficiary alive at the time of your death, benefits will be paid according to the policy contract: your spouse, if living; otherwise your children, if living; otherwise your parents, if living; otherwise your estate. Please designate beneficiaries to avoid this.


