



EUTF Prescription Drug Savings Guide

How to save money and time by managing your prescriptions with [Caremark.com](https://www.caremark.com) or the CVS Caremark™ app

Step 1: Register

Caremark.com and the CVS Caremark™ app have many features to help you manage your prescriptions, including making it easier to request an auto refill, start mail service, submit claims, view your ID card, and check drug costs.

Computer: Go to Caremark.com. If you do not have a Caremark.com account, click **Register**. Enter your CVS member ID or prescription number (Mail Rx#).

Mobile App: Download the CVS Caremark™ app from the App Store or Google Play. Tap **Sign In** in the top right corner. If you do not have a Caremark.com account, tap **Open an account**. Enter your CVS member ID or prescription number (Mail Rx#).

Mail Rx# is a number for prescriptions received through CVS Mail Service.



The CVS Caremark™ app is a free mobile app available for download from the App Store or Google Play.

Step 2: Check Drug Costs

Generic medications cost up to 85% less than brand medications but work in the same way and are of the same quality. Both generic and brand medications contain the same active ingredients, have the same effectiveness and strength, and are approved by the U.S. Food and Drug Administration (FDA).

Step 2: Check Drug Costs (continued)

Using Caremark.com and the CVS Caremark™ app, you can check drug costs in real time and discuss lower cost alternatives such as generic medications with your doctor.

Computer: Sign in to Caremark.com and under **Plan & Benefits**, click **Check Drug Cost & Coverage**. Enter the drug name and click **Search**.

Mobile App: Sign in to the CVS Caremark™ app and under **Member tools**, select **Check Drug Costs**. Enter the drug name and tap **Search**.

Step 3: Start Mail Service

Getting your medications through mail order costs less and is convenient. Save time with fewer trips to the pharmacy and no line waiting. Every order is filled by a licensed pharmacist, quality checked, and delivered in discreet packaging that is tamper-proof, weather-proof and temperature controlled. Medications are delivered to a location of your choice, with no-cost shipping.

Computer: Sign in to Caremark.com and under **Prescriptions**, click **Start Rx Delivery by Mail**. **Search for a drug**, view **Past searches**, or **Request a previously filled prescription**. Select the drug you want to fill at mail and click **Request a New Prescription**. You can also download the Mail Service Order Form located under **Plan & Benefits – Print Plan Forms**.

Phone: Simply call CVS Customer Care at the toll-free number below and let them know that you would like to start mail service.

Doctor: Another option is to ask your doctor during your next doctor's visit to submit your 90-day prescription to CVS Caremark™ Mail Service Pharmacy for you.
