I. CALL TO ORDER

The meeting of the Board of Trustees of the Hawaii Employer-Union Health Benefits Trust Fund (EUTF) was called to order at 9:01 a.m. by Vice Chairperson Robert Yu, in the EUTF Board Room, 201 Merchant Street, Suite 1700, Honolulu, Hawaii, on Tuesday, May 27, 2025.

II. REVIEW OF MINUTES – APRIL 22, 2025

The Board reviewed the draft minutes of April 22, 2025. Since there were no edits or objections by the Trustees, the minutes stand approved.

III. EXECUTIVE SESSION

MOTION was made and seconded to move into Executive Session at 9:03 a.m. (Ferguson-Miyamoto/Wataru) The motion passed unanimously. (Employer Trustees-3/Employee-Beneficiary Trustees-5)

The regular meeting reconvened at 9:07 a.m.

2. Proposed HDS Plan Changes

<u>EUTF and HSTA VB Active Employees and Retirees Posterior Composite Filling</u> Benefit Change

Mr. Mizuno summarized the recommendation from the Benefits Committee.

MOTION was made and seconded to approve the Benefits Committee's recommendation to cover posterior composite fillings, subject to the annual deductible, at 80% under the EUTF and HSTA VB active employee and retiree dental plans and at 45% under the HSTA VB active employee supplemental dental plan effective January 1, 2026 and transfer of \$25.7 million from the EUTF Trust Fund to the OPEB Trust Fund. (Tui/Wataru) The motion passed unanimously. (Employer Trustees-3/Employee-Beneficiary Trustees-5)

Mr. Mizuno informed the Board that EUTF staff will not adjust the active employee premiums for the plan year July 1, 2025 – June 30, 2026 and will pay the additional premiums from excess funds.

HSTA VB Active Employee and Supplemental True Implant Benefit Change Mr. Mizuno summarized the recommendation from the Benefits Committee.

MOTION was made and seconded to approve the Benefits Committee's

recommendation to add a "true" implant benefit and remove the limitation that an implant be between two natural teeth under the HSTA VB active employee dental and supplemental dental plans effective July 1, 2026. (Tui/Ferguson-Miyamoto) The motion passed unanimously. (Employer Trustees-3/Employee-Beneficiary Trustees-5)

- 3. Kaiser Permanente Senior Advantage Plan Part D Threshold Mr. Mizuno summarized the Benefits Committee report noting that the EUTF Board is not federally required to increase the annual out-of-pocket (OOP) prescription drug threshold to \$2,100 per calendar year in 2026 from the current \$2,000. Kaiser is able to retain the \$2,000 OOP for the EUTF and HSTA VB Kaiser Permanente Senior Advantage plans in 2026.
- 4. Proposed CVS Prescription Drug Plan Change
 Mr. Mizuno summarized the recommendation from the Benefits Committee.

MOTION was made and seconded to approve the Benefits Committee's recommendation to add a cumulative fill edit on antidiabetic and weight loss GLP1s simultaneously to the EUTF non-Medicare retiree prescription drug plan administered by CVS effective July 1, 2025. (Tui/Wataru) The motion passed unanimously. (Employer Trustees-3/Employee-Beneficiary Trustees-5)

Mr. Mizuno summarized Segal's annual review of the retiree plans.

V. OLD BUSINESS

A. New Secretary-Treasurer (Employer Trustee) Effective July 1, 2025 Mr. Mizuno informed the Board that they can select Secretary-Treasurer from the employer trustees today for a July 1, 2025 effective date.

MOTION was made and seconded to appoint Trustee Sabrina Nasir as Secretary-Treasurer of the Board effective July 1, 2025. (Wataru/Ferguson-Miyamoto) The motion passed unanimously. (Employer Trustees-3/Employee-Beneficiary Trustees-5)

B. Claims Audit Report – PSG Prescription Claims Audit of CVS/SilverScript for Active Employees July 1, 2021 – June 30, 2022 and Retirees January 1, 2021 – December 31, 2022

Mr. Mizuno noted that PSG presented the claims audit report at the last board meeting. The revised reports include two additional columns to show amounts previously paid and the remaining amounts to be paid by CVS/SSI. Mr. Mizuno also noted that the CVS rebate finding represents amounts that CVS overpaid. EUTF will refund CVS the overpayment amounting to \$34,997.

Trustee Ryan Yamane entered the meeting at 9:22 a.m., during the presentation.

C. 2025 EUTF Related Legislation

Mr. Mizuno noted that the EUTF bill was signed into law as Act 054. SB1651 and HB250 related to posting of board materials three business days prior to the board meeting and appointment of two EUTF representatives to a utilization management working group,

B. Investment Committee

1. Quarterly Performance Report – Q1 2025

Mr. Colin Bebee, Meketa Investment (Meketa), presented the first-quarter performance report. The OPEB Trust finished the quarter at \$8.6 billion, down -0.10% (net of fees), underperforming the policy benchmark which returned 0.8%. Since inception (June 23, 2011), the portfolio has returned 7.1% (net of fees) and is exceeding the actuarial return target of 7%. In the first quarter, systematic trend following within diversifying strategies and private equity within aggressive growth were the primary sources of underperformance.

The EUTF Trust Fund finished the quarter at \$534.6 million, up 0.4% for the quarter (net of fees). Since inception (October 1, 2013), the portfolio has returned 3.7% (net of fees).
